## **Purpose**



#### What is Oracle FastConnect?

- Oracle FastConnect is a network connectivity alternative to using the public internet for connecting your network with Oracle Cloud Infrastructure and other Oracle Cloud services.
- FastConnect provides an easy, elastic, and economical way to create a dedicated and private connection with higher bandwidth options, and a more reliable and consistent networking experience when compared to internet-based connections.
- Use Oracle FastConnect to extend your existing private networks to Oracle Cloud Infrastructure, via provider networks.

# Creating FastConnect with an Oracle provider to obtain an OCID

Learn how to create an Oracle FastConnect in the Oracle Console (summary below)

- Log in to Oracle Console.
- Create a Virtual Cloud Network (VCN)\*.
- Create a DRG and attach to VCN\*.
- 4. Create a FastConnect connection with the proper Virtual Circuit (Private).
- Enter details.
- Copy the Oracle Cloud ID (OCID). (Share this OCID with the Lumen Provisioning team upon request.)
- 7. Update/create a route rule to include your location subnets pointing to the DRG as the next hop.
